Creative Commons licenses

- A CC license is a public copyright license that allows creators to share their work with others under specific conditions
- Creators must always be attributed and the original publication be named otherwise known as a citation
 - Creators can limit re-use to non-commercial context, prohibit derivative works

Why are CC licenses relevant?

CC licenses facilitate scholarly communication and make research reusable and accessible. Originating in the arts, CC licenses have become a standard in scholarly publication.
