## Creative Commons licenses

A CC license is a public copyright license that allows creators to share their work with others under specific conditions

Creators must always be attributed and the original publication be named – otherwise known as a citation

Creators can limit re-use to non-commercial context, prohibit derivative works

## Why are CC licenses relevant?

CC licenses facilitate scholarly communication and make research reusable and accessible. Originating in the arts, CC licenses have become a standard in scholarly publication.

## Licensing consultation service

We help you to determine which license is the most appropriate for your publication.

For Gold Open Access publications, we generally recommend the CC BY (Attribution) license.
