Persistent Identifiers (PID)

DOI (Digital Object Identifiers)

Persistently identify digital content, such as articles, books, data sets and much more

ORCID (Open Researcher and Contributor ID)

Links researchers to their work, identity and their institution – your personal ID in academia

ROR ID (Research Organization Registry ID)

The global open registry of research organizations unambiguously identifies your affiliation

Why use PID?

PID provide unique identifiers to ensure clarity and consistency in scholarly communications. Most commonly used PID are provided by non-profit organizations, keeping scholarly communication in the hands of academia.

We provide consultation on best practices in the application of PID. GU affiliates can register DOI for their work through the university library and its publication platforms.
